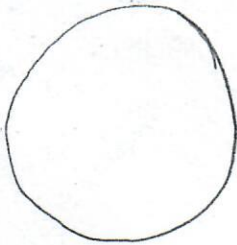
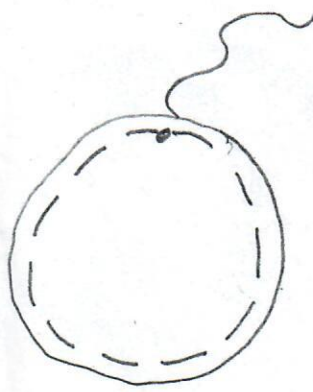


How To Make A Fabric Button

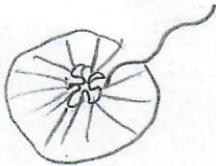

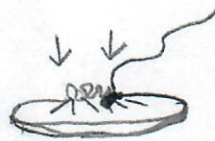
- ① Cut Fabric Circles 2x desired width of button.



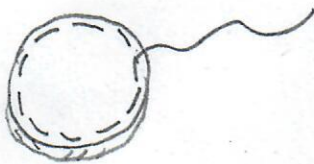
- ② Use a Running Stitch around edge of circle.



- ③ Gather edges up together by pulling thread snugly.



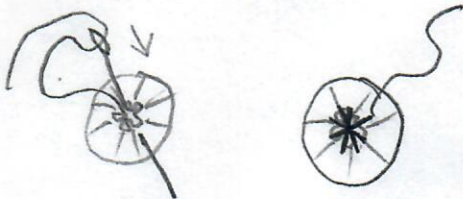
- ④ Knot then flatten out Buttons.



- ⑤ Turn over and do another Running stitch around the folded edge of circle.



- ⑥ Gather edges up together to form a dome, (can use scrap or stuffing to fill more if needed)



- ⑦ Tighten the folds into the button shape by stitching across the opening, working your way around.



- ⑧ Knot and leave @ 1.8" of thread to attach to garment. May also make a shank by stitching a loop then do a buttonhole stitch around the loop to reinforce.

Sew on with hanging threads
