

HOW TO MAKE A QUICK TASSEL

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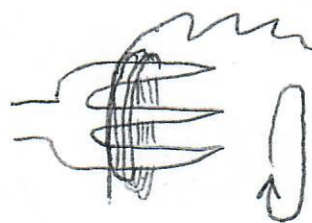
Large Fish Fork and
Your Choice of Embroidery
floss, Yarn, or thread.
@ yard long and scissors,

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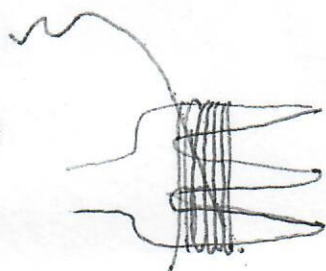
Start With end of
thread downward,

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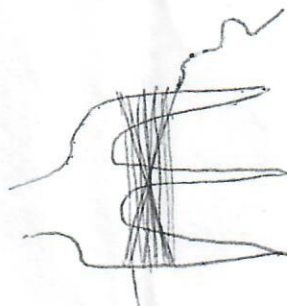
Wrap thread around
largest point on fork
making sure threads
are snug but not
pulling or stretching
Wrap @ 7 times, both
threads together (wrap
goes left to right),

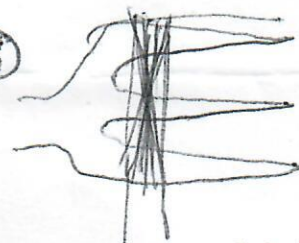
Continue next layer by
coming back to beginning,
wrapping back to end,
and work your way ~~across~~
another @ 7 times, wrapping
starts from Right Bottom and
goes over left top. ~~is~~

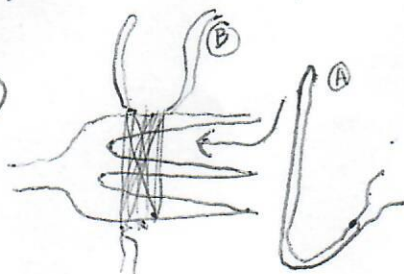
This creates an "x"
on the fork over the
vertical threads.
Repeat process going
the reverse direction
another @ 7 times to
create the third layer.

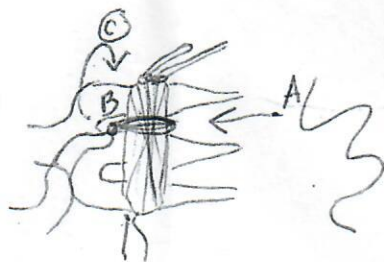
Usually 20-30 wraps
makes a nice tassel.
Cut thread hanging down
like beginning.

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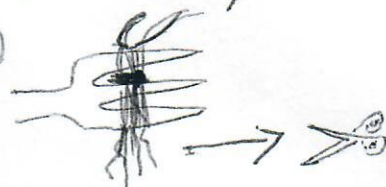
Take 8" of thread folded
in half and bring through
the upper eye between
the wrapped layers (A).
Pull up to top of tassel
and tightly tie into square
knot (B) leave threads to
attach to other items.

Take remaining thread
and, while leaving extra
thread for knotting, (A)
wrap completely around
all layers of tassel,
going around at
least 6-8 times tightly.
Finish with square knot
to complete band, Bring
knot ends up and under
band to secure. (C)

Tassel can be adjusted
for neatness. Slide
tassel off fork. Use
Scissors to cut bottom
loops in half then
trim and loose thread
to match.
